COMMUNITY DATA IS FRAGMENTED

DATA CURATION IS DIFFICULT

- Collecting, formatting, and maintaining datasets takes too much time & effort
- Takes away from decision-making and taking action

A centralized dashboard for Dunn County data



Hundreds of local metrics in one place



Automatically updates, giving the most reliable data



Tracks trends over time to better understand progress
